In accordance with **County Code §701.07(C)**, the following is the monthly update for **April 2024**.

Gross Sales Tax receipts (before allocation to General Fund and Debt Service) totaled \$25.3 million in the month of April 2024. Year-to-date sales tax receipts totaled \$111.5 million, which represents a year over year increase of 0.2%.

• General Fund:

The most significant source of revenue is Sales Taxes. Year-to-date Sales Taxes allocated to the General Fund total \$108.5 million. The following tables summarize General Fund revenues, expenditures and subsidies:

• Significant Changes:

- Council approved the **annual cash transfer of \$3,800,000** from the Community Development (Casino Tax) fund to the Economic Development Fund.
- Council approved a cash transfer of \$1,500,000 from the Community Development (Casino Tax) to the Community Development Supplemental Grant fund which was approved by O2020-0001.
- Council approved appropriations of \$3,600,000 for the Child Wellness Campus. This funding was received from the Board of Developmental Disabilities (BODD) and the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Service Board (ADAMHS). This funding will provide short-term emergency bed services through the Center for Families and Children T-Suites program.
- The County issued payment in the amount of \$37,513,011.97 for the land purchase in Garfield Heights for Central Service Campus.
