In accordance with County Code §701.07(C), the following is the monthly update for January 2024.

Gross Sales Tax receipts (before allocation to General Fund and Debt Service) totaled \$26.6 million in the month of January 2024. Year-to-date sales tax receipts totaled \$26.6 million, which represents a year over year decrease of 1.4%.

• General Fund:

The most significant source of revenue is Sales Taxes. Year-to-date Sales Taxes allocated to the General Fund total \$26.1 million. The following tables summarize General Fund revenues, expenditures and subsidies:

• Significant Changes:

 In December, we reduced excess budget appropriations totaling \$265,507,211. By fund type:

Debt Service Fund	\$ 11,959,466
Enterprise Funds	\$ 7,666,072
Internal Service Funds	\$ 9,804,846

- In January, we received a Certificate of Estimated Resources from the Budget Commission certifying appropriations do not exceed resources for 2024.
- The required Cash Reserve Balances have been calculated for 2024. The Cash Reserve balance for the General Fund increased by \$9,885,647 to \$147,204,425 and the Cash Reserve balance for the Health and Human Services Levy Funds decreased by \$1,096,057 to \$27,346,437.
- o In January, Council approved monthly **Health and Human Services Levy subsidy transfers** to both ADAMHS \$3,416,667 and MetroHealth \$2,916,667.
