CURRENT PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY –

Fatal Cases due to heroin/fentanyl/analogs in MAY- at least 43 (10 cases pending testing)

17 - City of Cleveland Residents

22 - Suburban Residents- Beachwood, Bedford, Cleveland Hts., (2), Euclid, Fairview Park (2), Garfield Hts. Glenwillow, Lyndhurst, Maple Hts., Mayfield Hts., Middleburgh Hts. (3), Newburgh Hts., North Olmsted, North Royalton, Parma (2), Parma Hts., Strongsville

4 – Out of County –Ashtabula (Ashtabula Co.), Eastlake and Mentor (Lake Co.) and Valley City (Medina Co.)

VICTIMS

Victims' ages range from 21 - 72

34 Male victims; 9 Female victims

7 African American victims; and 36 Caucasian victims (6 hispanic victims)


TRENDS

At least **246** victims have died from heroin/fentanyl/analog or in combination through July 2020. This compares to 238 in 2019; 220 in 2018 and 345 in 2017. 2020 total is at least **341** fatalities when including cocaine as well.


Carfentanil: 191 cases in 2017; 24 cases in 2018; 220 in 2019; 48 confirmed in 2020 as of 8/9/20

Rate of African American deaths involving fentanyl is 23.21% of all victims in 2020, slightly less than the 27.11% in 2019, but much higher than 2016 (14.5%), the 20.33% in 2017 and 21.11 in 2018. As many as 35 cocaine related deaths occurred in July 2020 with as many as 22 being mixed with Fentanyl, Heroin or both.




















