CURRENT PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY –

Fatal Cases due to heroin/fentanyl/analogs in APRIL– at least **34 (13 cases pending testing)**

20 - City of Cleveland Residents

11 - Suburban Residents- Euclid (2), Garfield Hts., Lakewood (5), North Royalton, Parma, Parma Heights, and

3– Out of County –Brunswick (Medina Co.), Chardon (Geauga Co.) and Eastlake (Lake Co.)

VICTIMS

Victims' ages range from under 18 - 71

25 Male victims; 9 Female victims

5 African American victims; 1 native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander; and 28 Caucasian victims (5 Hispanic victims)

TRENDS

At least **304** victims have died from heroin/fentanyl/analog or in combination through June 2021. This compares to 192 in 2020; 214 in 2019; 185 in 2018 and 292 in 2017. 2021 total is at least **351** fatalities when including cocaine as well.

Carfentanil: 191 cases in 2017; 24 cases in 2018; 220 in 2019; 63 confirmed in 2020; 3 as of 7/15/21

Rate of African American deaths involving fentanyl is 29.37% of all victims in 2021, higher than all previous years: 25.00% of all victims in 2020 and 27.80% in 2019, more than double the rate in 2016 (14.5%), and more than the 20.33% in 2017 and 21.61 in 2018. As many as 45 cocaine related deaths occurred in April 2021 with as many as 32 being mixed with Fentanyl, Heroin or both.

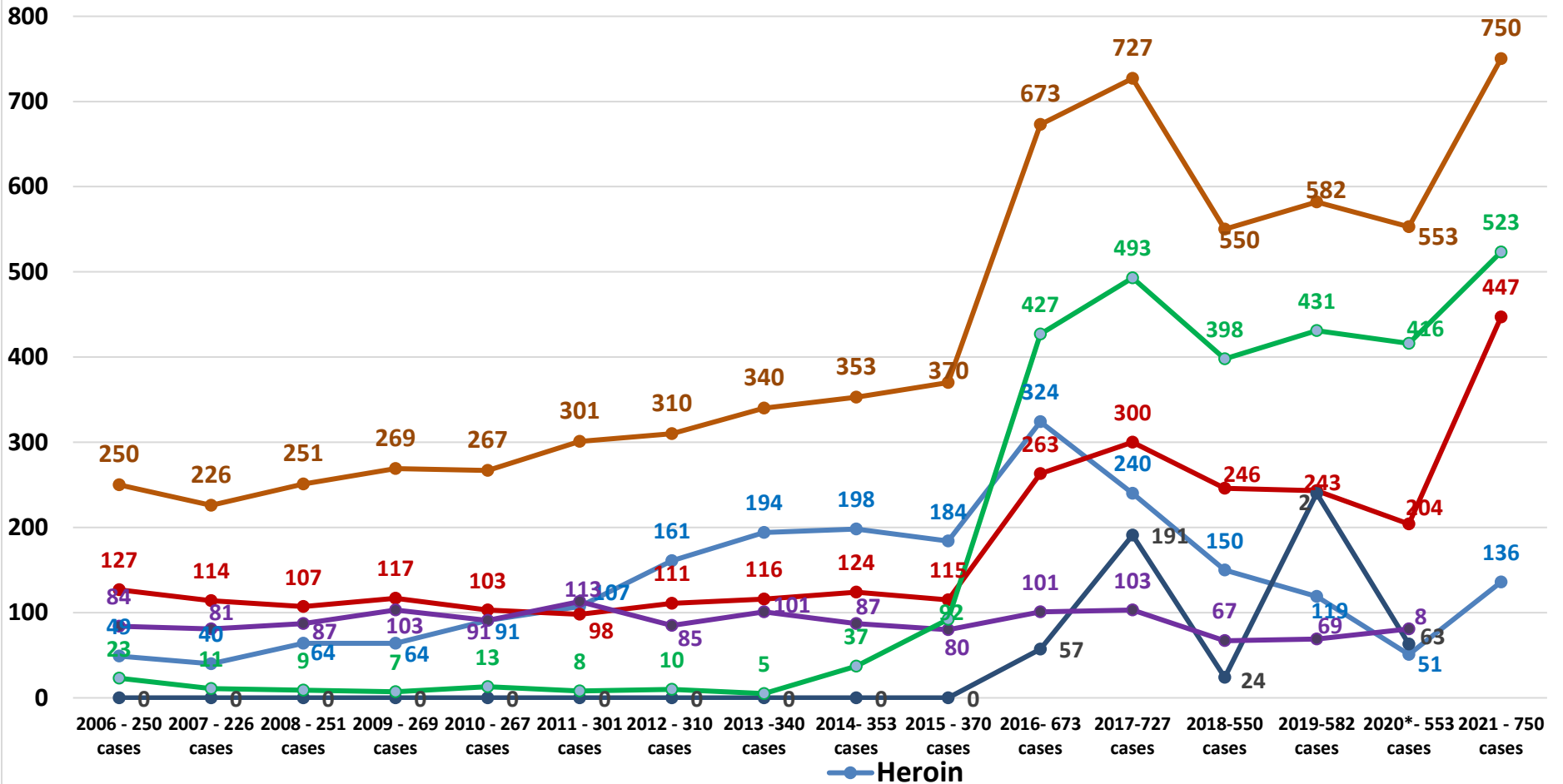

*(2021 projections based on data through July 15, 2021)



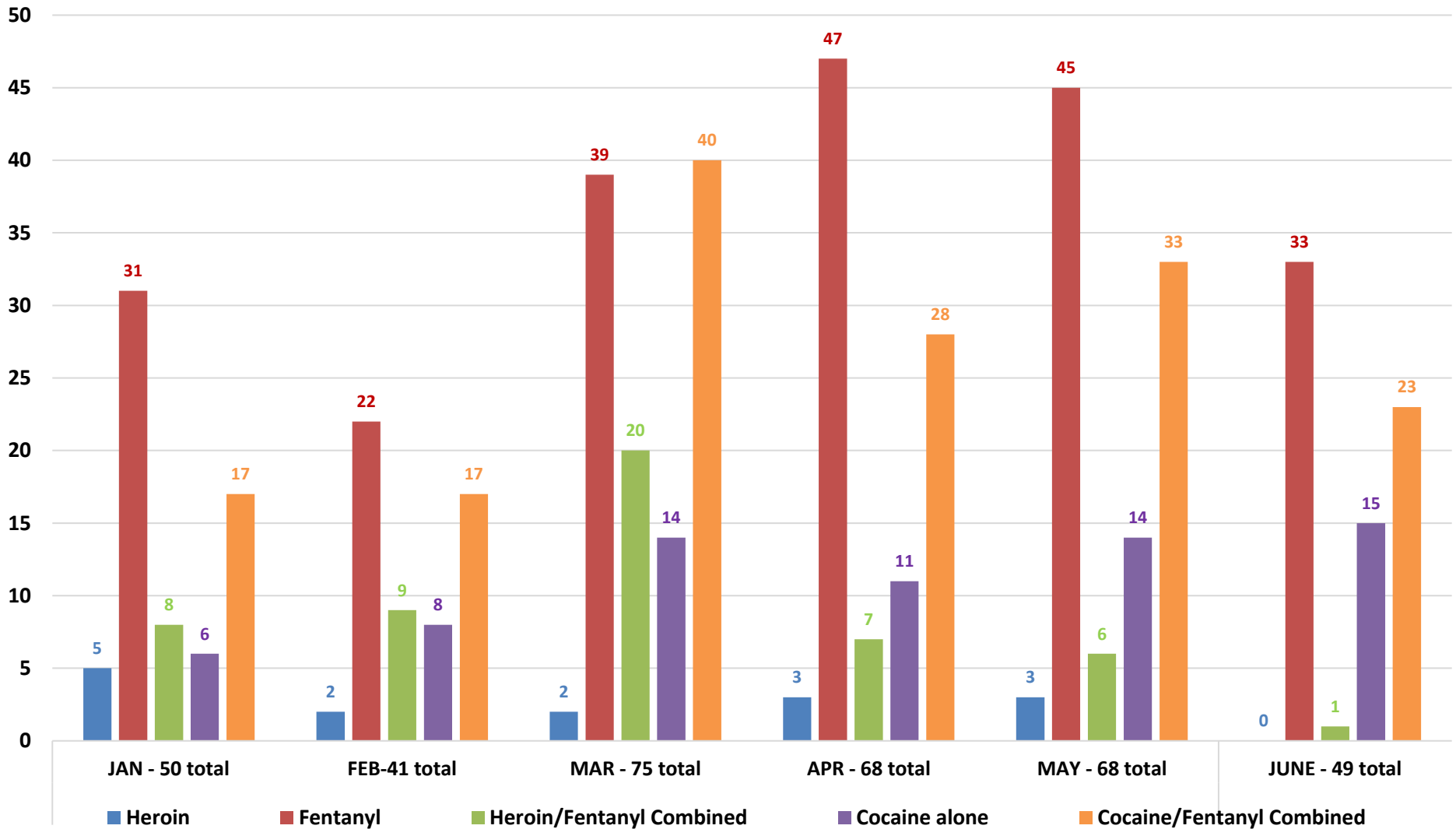

(Fentanyl analogues will be counted under Fentanyl Columns)

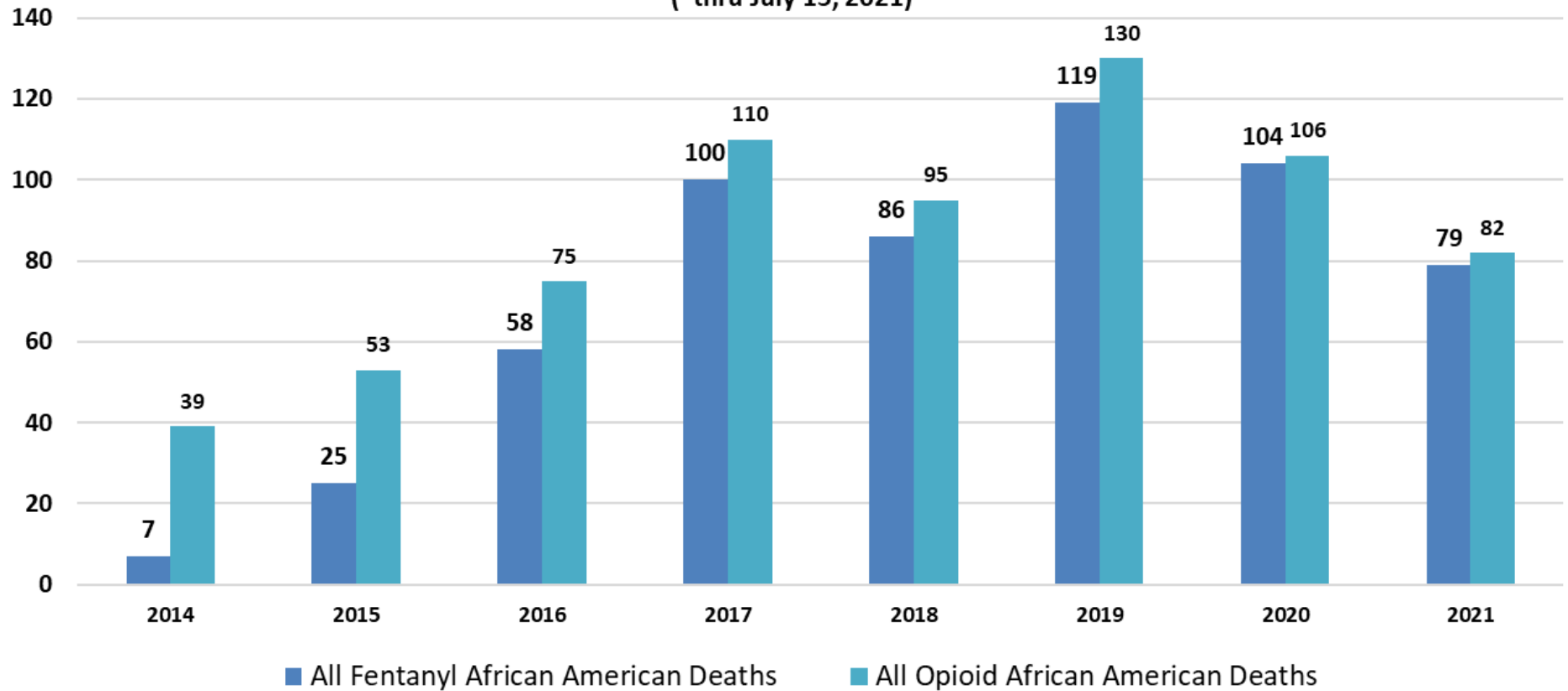

CCMEO Fentanyl-related fatalities among African Americans 2014-2021*

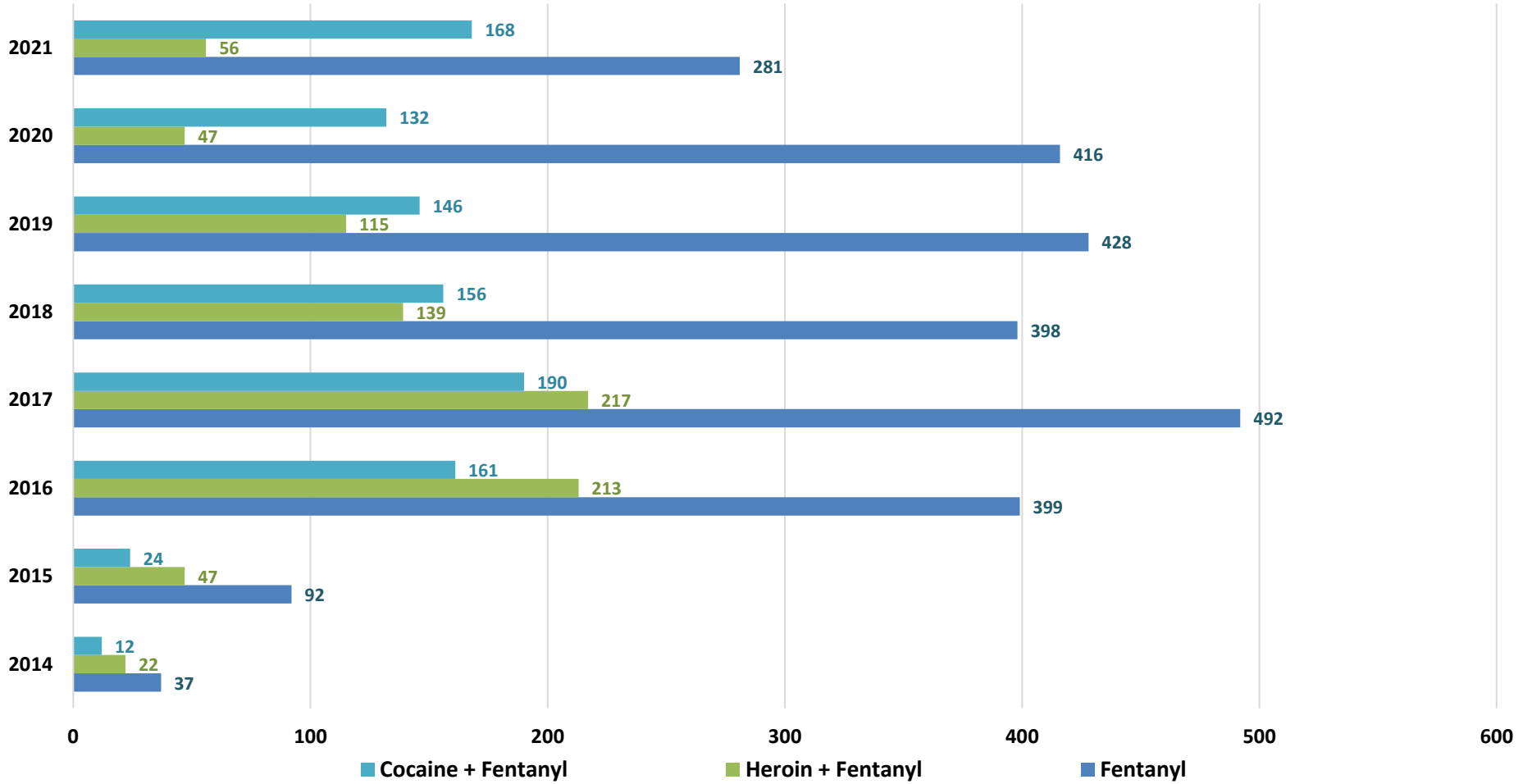

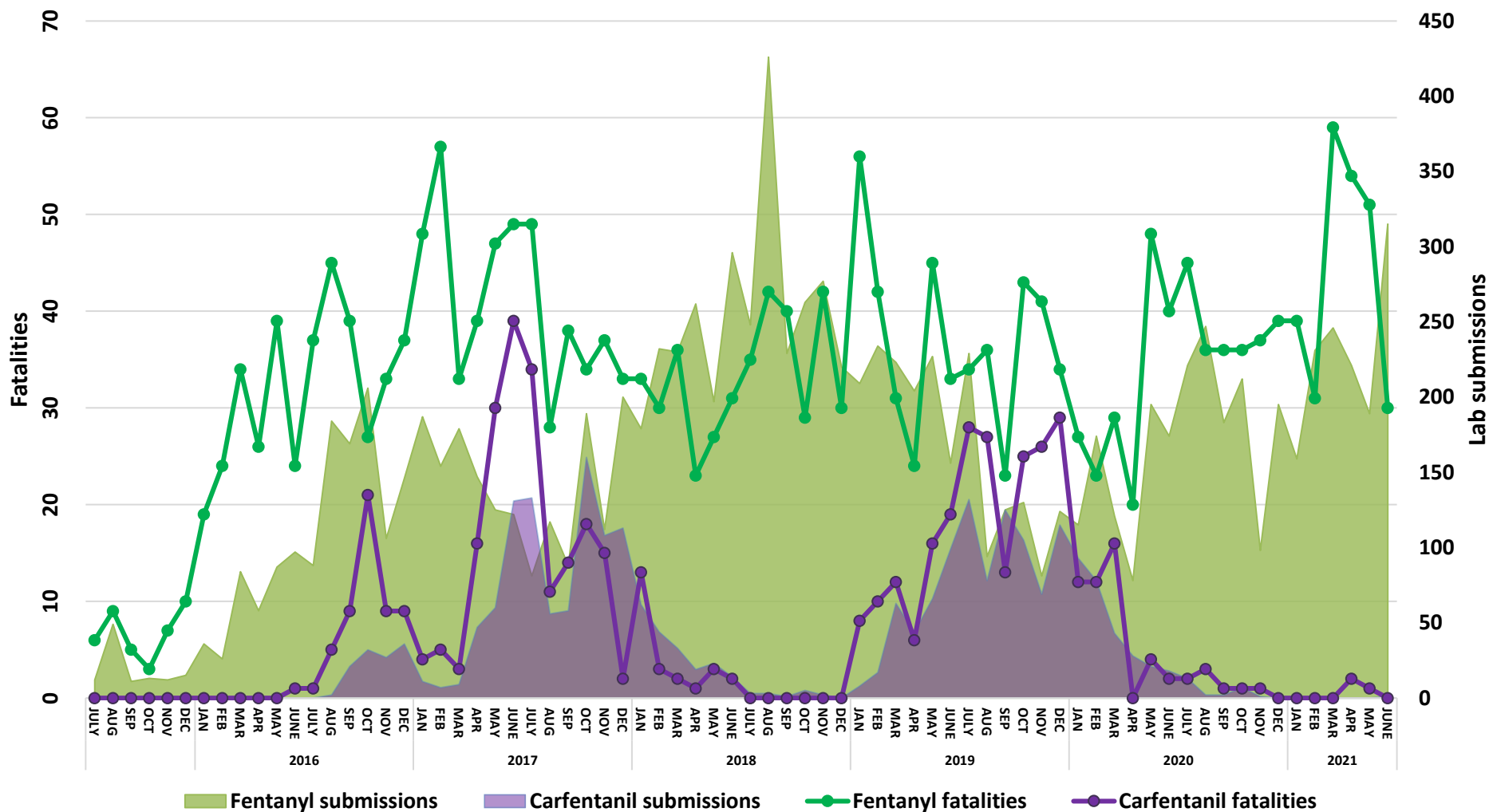

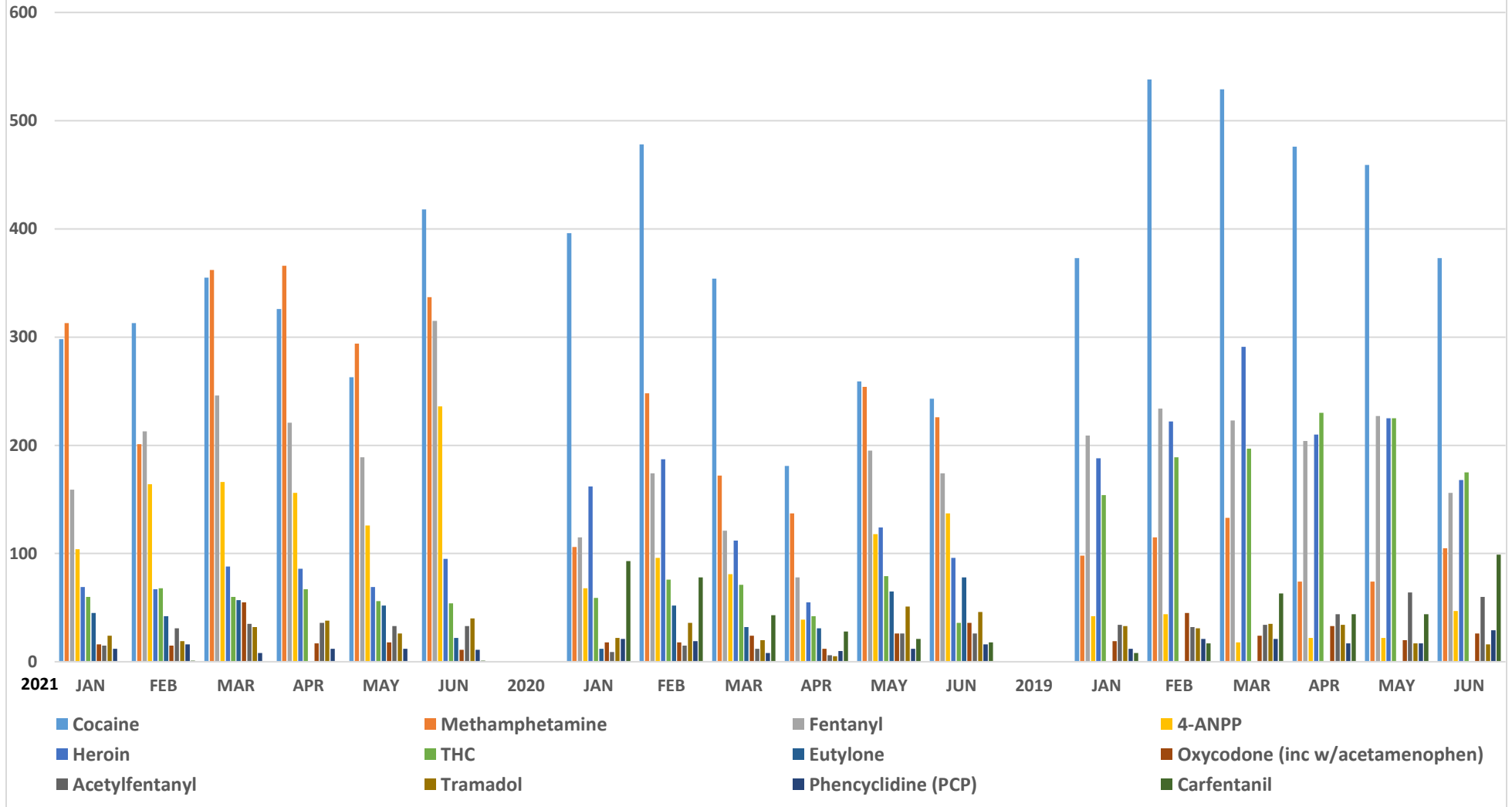
