CURRENT PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY –

Fatal Cases due to heroin/fentanyl/analogs in August- at least 40 (10 cases pending testing)

- 21 City of Cleveland Residents
- 18 Suburban Residents- Bedford (2), Berea (2), Brooklyn (2), Cleveland Hts., Euclid (5), Garfield Hts., Maple Hts.(2), South Euclid, Walton Hills and Westlake
- 1 Out of County North Ridgeville (Lorain Co.)

VICTIMS

Victims' ages range from under 27 - 75

24 Male victims; 16 Female victims

10 African American victims; 30 Caucasian victims; (0 Hispanic victims)

TRENDS


At least **334** victims have died from heroin/fentanyl/analog or in combination through August 2023. 2023 total is at least **427** fatalities when including cocaine as well.

<u>Carfentanil: 191 cases in 2017; 24 cases in 2018; 220 in 2019; 63 confirmed in 2020; 6 confirmed in 2021; 1 confirmed in 2022; 0 in 2023</u>

Rate of African American deaths involving fentanyl is 25% of all victims in August 2023 and over 35% for the year. As many as 35 cocaine related deaths occurred in August 2023 with as many as 25 being mixed with Fentanyl, Heroin or both.









2023 CCMEO Overdose Deaths, Most Common Drugs Involved *(thru August 31, 2023)

Combined is heroin and fentanyl or cocaine and fentanyl in some combination (Fentanyl analogues will be counted under Fentanyl Columns)
