### **CURRENT PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY –**

### Fatal Cases due to heroin/fentanyl/analogs in November – at least 39 (19 cases pending testing)

- 23 City of Cleveland Residents
- 12 Suburban Residents- Berea, Broadview Hts., Brooklyn, Euclid(3), Garfield Hts., Parma (5), and Solon
- 2 Out of County North Ridgeville (Lorain Co.), Willoughby (Lake Co.)
- 1 Unknown

### **VICTIMS**

Victims' ages range from under 23 - 71

26 Male victims; 13 Female victims

14 African American victims; 1 asian victim; 24 Caucasian victims; (3 Hispanic victims)


### **TRENDS**


At least **447** victims have died from heroin/fentanyl/analog or in combination through November 2023. 2023 total is at least **592** fatalities when including cocaine as well.

### <u>Carfentanil: 191 cases in 2017; 24 cases in 2018; 220 in 2019; 63 confirmed in 2020; 6 confirmed in 2021; 1 confirmed in 2022; 0 in 2023</u>

Rate of African American deaths involving fentanyl is 35.9% of all victims in November 2023 and over 34.68% for the year. As many as 32 cocaine related deaths occurred in November 2023 with as many as 20 being mixed with Fentanyl, Heroin or both.










### 2023 CCMEO Overdose Deaths, Most Common Drugs Involved \*(thru Nov. 30, 2023)
