XYLAZINE

Xylazine, also called, “tranq” or “tranq dope” is a non-opioid sedative, used as an animal tranquilizer in veterinary medicine causing painful skin/muscle **wounds**.

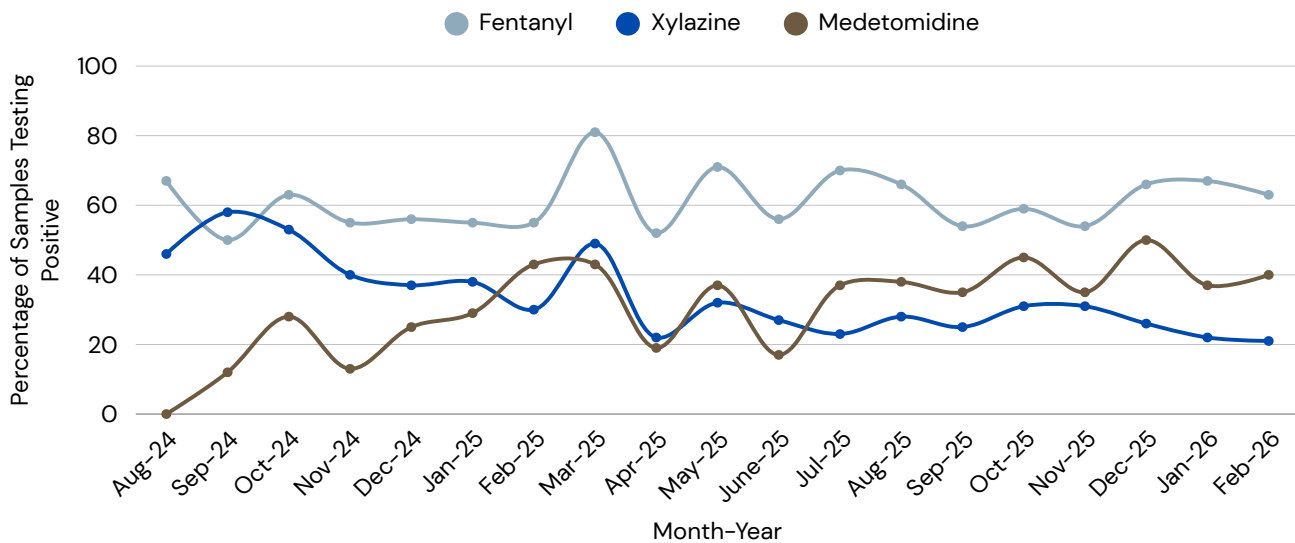
MEDETOMIDINE

Medetomidine or “rhino-traq” is a veterinary sedative, similar to Xylazine, that is 100 - 200 times more potent than xylazine resulting in **prolonged withdrawal symptoms**.

COMMON SYMPTOMS

- Commonly present with fentanyl
- Can slow down the brain and breathing
- Can lower blood pressure

OVERDOSE RESPONSE

1. Administer Naloxone



2. Restore Stable Breathing
