AMENDMENT TO THE  
BELLEFAIRE JEWISH CHILDREN'S BUREAU  
RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT SERVICES CONTRACT

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2012 by and between the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio (hereinafter called the "COUNTY"), the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Court Division (hereinafter called the "COURT") and **Bellefaire Jewish Children's Bureau**, a corporation not-for-profit, with principal offices located at 22001 Fairmount Boulevard, Shaker Heights, Ohio 44118, [REDACTED] (hereinafter called the "VENDOR").

WITNESS THAT:

WHEREAS, the COURT desires to engage the VENDOR'S professional and technical services to conduct programming, treatment, case management and care and custody services for youth in a residential treatment program, and the VENDOR can provide these services from February 1, 2012 to January 31, 2014.


NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed that the agreement by and between the COURT and the VENDOR for services is hereby amended to include the following revision to sections:

- To decrease the funds in the amount of \$50,000.00. This changes the not-to-exceed value of the contract from \$130,000.00 to \$80,000.00.
- ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES - By entering into this AGREEMENT, the VENDOR agrees on behalf of the contracting business entity, its officers, employees, subcontractors, subgrantees, agents or assigns, to conduct this transaction by electronic means by agreeing that all documents requiring county signatures may be executed by electronic means and that the electronic signatures affixed by the COUNTY to said documents shall have the same legal effect as if the signature was manually affixed to a paper version of the document. The VENDOR also agrees on behalf of the aforementioned entities and persons to be bound by the provisions of chapters 304 and 1306 of the Ohio Revised Code as they pertain to electronic transactions, and to comply with the electronic signature policy of Cuyahoga County.

All other sections of the original contract shall remain the same.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the COUNTY, the COURT and the VENDOR have executed this amendment to the contract.
