4,	That the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio shall give notice to the Contractor and the Contractor shall give notice to the subcontractors that they shall file certified payroll reports and the affidavit required by Ohio Revised Code, Sections 4115.07 and 4115.071.
5,	That the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio shall appoint a Prevailing Wage Coordinator who shall exercise the duties imposed by the Ohio Revised Code, Section 4115.071 and as set forth by the Ohio Attorney General. The duties of the Prevailing Wage Coordinator are incorporated herein:  a) Set up and maintain files containing all contractors' and subcontractors' payroll reports.  b) Maintain a list of pay dates.  c) Within two (2) weeks after the first payday, receive from each contractor a certified copy of its payroll report. Certified means that it must be
	sworn to and signed by the Contractor.
	<ol> <li>If the project is to exceed four (4) months, all reports after the initial report (the initial report must be filed within two (2) weeks) can be filed once per month.</li> </ol>


