## AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE AND THE FRANKLIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

## **RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, Ohio ICAC is the recipient of grant funds from OJJDP for the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Continuation Grant Program for fiscal year 2011 pursuant to grant number 2009-MC-CX-K031; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and Ohio ICAC, along with the US Attorney General's Office, will provide 2 days of training for approximately 300 law enforcement personnel from agencies throughout the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the trainings will focus on improving and expanding law enforcement's capabilities to protect the community from Internet-related crimes; and

WHEREAS, the trainings will be held July 7-8, 2011 at the Ohio Union, 1739 N. High Street Columbus, Ohio 43210; and

WHEREAS, the cost for these 2 days of training will not exceed thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000.00), and Ohio ICAC will pay for the total cost of this training from OJJDP funds; and

WHEREAS, Ohio ICAC will use training funds drawn from the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Continuation Grant number 2009-MC-CX-K031 to pay for this 2 days of training

WHEREAS, the signatories agree that in order to plan and implement the trainings, there will be certain reporting requirements that are required by OJJDP;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the parties agree as follows:

1. The Ohio ICAC and the Sheriff will be responsible for providing 2 days of training, July 7-8, 2011 at the Ohio Union, 1739 N. High Street Columbus, Ohio 43210 that will be paid from Grant number 2009-MC-CX-K031 and will comply with all grant and Program requirements.



- 2. Each party to this Agreement will appoint a representative who will be available to meet from time to time at the request of the Director of Ohio ICAC and who will continue to be available to meet throughout fiscal year 2011.
- 3. The Ohio ICAC shall reimburse Franklin County Sheriff's Office for the costs of training in an amount not-to-exceed \$33,000 within 30 days of receipt of invoices and receipts evidencing expenditures.
- 4. The agreement can be terminated either by (a) agreement of the parties, upon thirty (30) days' notice; or (b) earlier by Ohio ICAC upon notification that funds for the project are no longer available.
