DESCRIPTION:

(Exhibit A), the need for the County to install an actuated pedestrian signal for Quincy Avenue. The Quincy Parking Lot is the primary location for parking for the public & court staff. Over 400 pedestrians will be crossing back and forth daily and the posted speed limit on Quincy is 35mph. To ensure the utmost in public safety while crossing; it is warranted to install an actuated pedestrian signal. The City of Cleveland is picking up their labor & material cost for the pedestrian signal. The County is picking up their portion of the pedestrian signal which is a part of this change order.

Lastly, some monies need to be set aside in the event unforeseen conditions arise in the construction and installation of the actuated pedestrian signal.
