WHEREAS, the agency was awarded the State RFP as the Regional Resource and Referral agency for childcare and out-of-school time.

WHEREAS, the agency is responsible for the region, that includes Cuyahoga County.

WHEREAS, the county changed the out-of-school time model to take the program countywide

WHEREAS, an amendment to Contract number CE1100531-01 is necessary and the parties hereto, mutually agree as follows:

THEREFORE, the following amendment to the aforementioned contract has been agreed to by and between the parties hereto, as follows:

- 1. That the reason for this amendment is to amend the contract period from October 1, 2011 September 30, 2012 to the time period of October 1, 2011- August 31, 2013.
- 2. That the amount of the amendment is increased by \$1,500,000.00 increasing the original contract from \$1,000,000.00 to \$2,500,000.00.
- 3. The Agency acknowledges the following changes in the scope of services to the original contract. The initials of the Agency on the line below show acknowledgement.
 - Starting Point will release a county-wide RFP in the summer of 2012 to begin year around services on September 1, 2012.
 - Starting Point will issue performance based contracts with 28 communities throughout Cuyahoga County.
 - ≥11 City of Cleveland neighborhoods at \$45,000 each
 - ➤11 Inner-ring suburban communities at \$30,000 each
 - 6 Outer-ring suburban communities at \$15,000 each
 - Identification of services must be connected to a community plan as a response to a service gap.
 - Services must focus on social and emotional development, academic improvement, leadership, employment preparation, and improved health and wellness.

- Eligible communities must identify a funding or an approved in-kind match
- Eligible communities must participant in mandatory services from the Agency:
 - ➤ Social Solutions Efforts-to-Outcome data collection process
 - ➤ Youth Program Quality Assessment (YPQA)
 - ➤ Professional development
 - ➤ Naviance Higher Education Compact (Cleveland neighborhoods)
 - ➤ Cuyahoga County Youth Development Early Warning System

The total amount of the contract cannot exceed **\$2,500,000.00** over the life of this contract. If the amount of the invoices exceeds the amount of the contract, the Provider realizes that no additional funds will be paid over and above the total amount of the contract, under any circumstances, even if additional services are provided.

- 5. The agency will issue 3 one year contracts, based on the availability of funding and performance, to maintain consistency with the Youth Program Quality Assessment (YPQA) and Social Solutions Efforts-to-Outcome data collection process.
- 6. The Agency agrees that all records, documents, writing, and other information, created or used pursuant to this Agreement or acquired with grant funds will become the property of the County. This includes all documents, reports, data, photographs including negatives), and electronic reports and records. County will maintain the unrestricted right to reproduce, distribute, modify, maintain, and use the media in anyway County deems appropriate. Agency further agrees not to seek or obtain copyright, patent or other proprietary protection for any materials or items produced under this Agreement. Agency understands that all materials and items produced under this Agreement will be made freely available to the public unless County determines that certain materials are confidential under federal or state law.
- 7. The Agency will work with local libraries to provide tutoring programs that support academic improvement.
- 8. The Agency will contract with Scenarios USA to assist in maintaining the countywide literature/screen writing contest.
- 9. The Agency will provide Professional Development session to funded and unfunded outof-time partners.
- 10. The Agency will provide transition services that include transition to kindergarten (Kindergarten Kits) and college access services.
