C O N T R A C T

THIS Contract made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 20__ by and between the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio (the "County"), and Fluorescent Recycling Inc. (the "Contractor"), with principal offices located in Cleveland, Correspondence & Remittances to PO Box 22384 Beachwood, Ohio 44122.

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of payments hereinafter mentioned, to be made by the County, the Contractor agrees to furnish all the work required for disposing all materials required for Fluorescent Lamps/Ballasts and lead acid battery Recycles on Requisition #22453 for Cuyahoga County Department Public Works for the period March 1, 2012 through February 28, 2013 in accordance with the specifications and to the satisfaction and acceptance of the County.

The Contractor further covenants and agrees that the following documents shall be bound with or accompany and be an essential part of this contract: specifications predicated to this contract; the general clauses and covenants of the County in effect at the time this contract is entered into; mandated forms; Specification Sheets, and this Contract.

It is expressly stipulated and agreed that the Contractor hereby covenants and agrees that he/she has full knowledge of the site, plans, specifications, and conditions relative to the performance contemplated by this contract and made an essential part thereof, and that the affixing of this/her signature hereto shall constitute complete acceptance of and compliance with aforesaid specifications, and conditions.

In consideration of the premises the County agrees to pay to the Contractor a certain sum of money, which shall be as set forth in said Contract hereto and made a part hereof.
