

## **Design Phase Services Involving Criteria Architect**

- **Program Confirmation (3 mos.)** ١.
  - Gain a thorough understanding of the Initial Program
  - Challenge and test the Program while respecting all underlying goals and principles
    - **Example: Can efficiencies be gained (and costs**  $\succ$ reduced) by combining functions in a single space?
  - Confirm the Final Program with any adjustments (with sign-off of user groups and presentation to Steering Committee if there are any material modifications)
  - **Confirm a Program level Project Budget and Schedule**
  - Confirm "Test Fit" of design with target sites
  - **Obtain Program Approval from Ohio Dept. of Rehabilitation** and Corrections (ODRC)
- Schematic Design (SD) (3 mos.) П.






