TIPS TO KNOW: BEFORE AN CYBERATTACK

- CHECK YOUR CREDIT CARD, BANK STATEMENTS, AND REPORTS REGULARLY
 - IF YOU NOTICE STRANGE ACTIVITY, LIMIT THE DAMAGE BY CHANGING ALL OF YOUR INTERNET ACCOUNT PASSWORDS IMMEDIATELY

- IMPORTANT: R: A COMPANY WILL NOT CALL YOU AND ASK FOR CONTROL OF YOUR COMPUTER TO FIX IT. THIS IS A COMMON SCAM.
- IF YOU FIND A PROBLEM DISCONNECT YOUR DEVICE FROM THE INTERNET
- RUN A SECURITY SCAN ON YOUR DEVICE



- 1, USE STRONG PASSWORDS THAT ARE 12 CHARACTERS OR LONGER
- 2. USE A STRONGER AUTHENTICATION SUCH AS A PIN OR PASSWORD THAT ONLY YOU WOULD KNOW
- 3. WATCH FOR SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY
- 4. CHECK YOUR ACCOUNT STATEMENTS AND CREDIT REPORTS REGULARLY.
- 5. USE SECURE INTERNET COMMUNICATIONS
- 6. USE SITES THAT USE HTTPS IF YOU WILL ACCESS OR PROVIDE ANY PERSONAL INFORMATION
- 7. USE ANTIVIRUS AND MALWARE SOLUTIONS, AND FIREWALLS TO BLOCK THREATS.
- 8. REGULARLY BACK UP YOUR FILES
- 9. LIMIT THE PERSONAL INFORMATION YOU SHARE ONLINE.
- 10. PROTECT YOUR HOME NETWORK BY CHANGING THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND WIFI PASSWORDS REGULARLY



AFTER

- CONTACT BANKS, CREDIT CARD COMPANIES AND OTHER FINANCIAL SERVICE COMPANIES
- FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE OIG AND IC3
- REPORT IDENTITY THEFT TO THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION.
- IF YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER WAS COMPROMISED CONTACT THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION.
- IF YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE OR CAR REGISTRATION HAS
 BEEN STOLEN CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR
 VEHICLES
