
UNFORTUNATELY, ANIMALS ARE ALSO AFFECTED BY DISASTER. HERE ARE SOME YEAR-ROUND SAFETY TIPS TO PREPARE YOUR
PET FOR EMERGENCIES AND SOME SUGGESTIONS IN CASE YOU HAVE TO EVACUATE WITH YOUR PET.

MAKE A PLAN

- HAVE AN EVACUATION PLAN FOR YOUR PETS. KNOW A
 SAFE PLACE TO TAKE YOUR PETS BEFORE A DISASTER OR
 EMERGENCY OCCURS. MANY PUBLIC SHELTERS AND
 HOTELS DO NOT ALLOW PETS.
- DEVELOP A BUDDY SYSTEM. PLAN WITH NEIGHBORS, FRIENDS, OR RELATIVE TO MAKE SURE THAT SOMEONE IS AVAILABLE TO CARE FOR OR EVACUATE YOUR PETS IF YOU CANNOT
- HAVE YOUR PET'S IDENTIFICATION ON THEM. KEEP YOUR
 ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER UP-TO-DATE AND INCLUDE
 CONTACT INFORMATION FOR AN EMERGENCY CONTACT
 OUTSIDE YOUR IMMEDIATE AREA. MICROCHIP YOUR PET AS
 A BACKUP.
- IF YOU HAVE LARGE ANIMALS: PETS SUCH AS HORSES,
 GOATS, PIGS, ETC. REQUIRE SPECIAL CONSIDERATION
 WHEN PREPARING FOR A DISASTER. BELOW ARE SOME
 ADDITIONAL TIPS TO REMEMBER WHEN PREPARING FOR A
 DISASTER IF YOU OWN LARGE ANIMALS.



BUILD-A-KIT



- FIRST AID KIT
- COLLAR WITH ID TAG AND HARNESS OR LEASH.
- COPIES OF THE PET'S REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND OTHER RELEVANT DOCUMENTS IN WEATHERPROOF CONTAINERS AND ELECTRONIC COPIES.
- TRAVEL BAG, CRATE, OR STURDY CARRIER



- GROOMING ITEMS: PET SHAMPOO, CONDITIONER, AND OTHER ITEMS.
- SANITATION NEEDS. SUCH AS PET LITTER, LITTER BOX, NEWSPAPERS, PAPER TOWELS, PLASTIC TRASH BAGS, AND HOUSEHOLD CHLORINE BLEACH.
- PICTURE OF YOU AND YOUR PET AND DOCUMENTATION OF OWNERSHIP.
- TOYS, TREATS, BEDDING, OR OTHER ITEMS TO HELP REDUCE STRESS.
